909 East Market full with addition of Derby City Crossfit

The 909 East Market building has become fully leased with the addition of a new tenant, **Derby City Crossfit**.

Derby City Crossfit, a 3,000-square-foot complex with a pilates studio and on-site chiropractor, plans to open in about three weeks, according to a news release.

Other tenants in the 17,000-square-foot 909 East Market Building include Cake Flour, **Stremelyne Media Group**, **Sign-A-Rama Downtown** and **FranchiseMart** Louisville.

Sign-A-Rama Downtown and FranchiseMart are owned by the building's owner, Maggie Harlow.

The location was a huge selling point for the building, she said in a the release. "Traffic flow is easy in and out of our facility, and we are 'on the way' for those who are traveling in or out of downtown," she said in the release.

Harlow and her husband, Brian Harlow, bought the building in 2006.
