## Persimmon Ridge



### breakdown

**The basics:** The 18-hole championship layout takes golfers through woods, over creeks, around lakes and through a 120-foot elevation. The the par-72 course features 7,113 yards of golf from the longest tees. The course rating is 75.4 and it has a slope rating of 148. Prior to construction, 487 trees on the grounds were surveyed for preparation for the golf course design, which won the prestigious Golf Digest 2007 Outstanding Design award.

**Signature hole:** 13 (par 4): 429 yards

**Last hole-in-one:** Donnie Young on hole No. 4, July 4, 2008

**Interesting Facts:** Members who score a birdie on hole 7 place a golf ball on the nearby grave of Elmore Just as a salute to the founding owner. The course's name was derived from Just's knowledge of persimmon wood golf clubs.
